Paiwalla is a significant environmental site in the lower Murray Darling Basin, recognised for the protection and growth of populations of many species of flora and fauna.



Paiwalla, formerly a dairy farm on the floodplains of the lower Murray has been restored to a wetland mimicking the conditions prior to regulation of River Murray flows, by the Wetland Habitat (Paiwalla) Association Inc.

The Association is a community group of 'Unit Holders' who own the site and seek to reinstate and maintain a natural environment, where there was once a dairy farm.

The Association's work has seen a proliferation of birdlife, an extensive revegetation program, the control of weeds and feral animals, a growing population of aquatic life and a unique water management regime to maintain water quality in the wetland.



While the Unit Holders are the mainstay of those that visit to enjoy and work to achieve the new environmental outcomes, there are many individuals who occasionally or regularly visit to enjoy what is on offer. There are also individuals who volunteer their expertise and labour while enjoying the unique environment.



The Association announces a mechanism for individuals and families to make an ongoing commitment to the Wetland and to enjoy benefits as a 'friend'.
